

Barons Court Caravan Park - Guidelines

This is a Caravan and Motorhome Club Certificated Location, which accepts just five caravans, motorhomes, campervans, folding campers and trailer tents and is for **Caravan and Motorhome Club Members only**.

Thank you for choosing to stay at Barons Court Caravan Park, we hope you will enjoy your stay. Please find below the guidelines applicable to our site.

General

Please consider other users of the site and we ask that all members of your party and any guests conduct themselves at all times with due regard to the health and safety of themselves and others.

A maximum stay allowed is 28 days, after which time your pitch must be vacated for 24 hours before you can return to the pitch.

No hen or stag parties please.

No unit to be left unoccupied overnight.

Arrival and Departure - Pitches are available from 2 pm. Pitches will usually be held until 8 pm of the day of arrival. Where a booking is not taken up by this time it will be considered cancelled, unless prior arrangement has been made with Barons Court Caravan Park.

On arrival, please report to Barons Court (house) and we will have pleasure in showing you your pitch.

We have a 6 metre rule which means that units (excluding guy ropes) must be 6 metres apart from adjacent units in order to protect against fire.

Please ensure the mains electrical cable from the hook up point to your unit and the unit's installation are safe. All units should be protected by a residual current device (RCD).

Pitches should be vacated by 11 am on the day of departure. Please ensure you leave your pitch clean and tidy on departure.

BBQs - Barbeques must be purpose built and portable, standing clear of the ground. There must be no possibility of damage to the ground. Only gas or charcoal barbeques should be used. We can provide you with bricks to raise your BBQ off the ground. Please put all the ashes (once cooled) in the metal bin provided (near the recycling).

Children - Children are welcome at Barons Court Caravan Park and are your responsibility. They are very welcome to stroke the animals (under supervision) but please do not allow them to play in the fields where the animals are. Please ensure they wash their hands after they have stroked the animals

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Drones and Photographs -The flying of drones from Barons Court Caravan Park and/or taking photos/videos of Barons Court Caravan Park is NOT permitted without our prior consent.

We sometimes take photographs of the CL for our Facebook page or website. Please let us know if you would prefer that we don't include you.

Electric Cars - No charging of electric cars is permitted on site.

Gazebos and Pup Tents - Gazebos and pup tents (1 man tents- as long as they are only used for sleeping) are permitted at Barons Court Caravan Park as long as it is within your pitch.

Livestock - We do have livestock on the smallholding which you are welcome to stroke (but please do not enter the fields unless you are accompanied by Steph or Nick). Please do not feed any of the animals. Please do not put things over the fence eg towels as they may be eaten by the goats!! After petting the animals, please ensure that you wash your hands immediately.

Noise - Noise must be kept to a reasonable level at all times so as not to disturb the enjoyment of others. Noise should be kept to a minimum between 10 pm and 7 am.

Pets - Well behaved pets are welcome at Barons Court Caravan Park but you are responsible for the behaviour of your animals. Please ensure that your animals are not allowed loose on site and are kept on a lead. The maximum number of dogs per pitch is 2 large dogs or 3 small dogs. If you want to bring more dogs, please phone or email us before making the booking.

We do not allow on site any breed (Pit Bull Terrier, Japanese Tosa, Dogo Argentino and Fila Brasileiro) of dog listed under the Dangerous Dogs act 1991.

With the exception of assistance dogs, pets are not allowed in the toilet and shower block.

Please ensure that you clear up after your dog(s). A bin is provided (near the recycling).

We do have livestock on the smallholding so please do not let your dog(s) worry the livestock. Ask Nick or Steph which field you can walk your dog(s) in as it depends where the sheep are at the time.

There are lots of walking and cycle routes nearby. Please familiarise yourself with The Countryside Code.

Recycle - Please could you place your everyday rubbish in the recycling bins provided. Please do not leave broken items (eg chairs, etc) or large packaging (eg cardboard boxes from new items) as we are unable to dispose of them.

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Pitches - We are open all year – we have 5 hardstandings and 2 grass pitches. As stated by the Caravan and Motorhome Club, only 5 pitches will be in use at any one time. We **do not** allow Motorhomes and campervans on the grass pitches at any time of the year.

During the booking process you are asked if you would like grass or hardstanding. Please understand that it may not always be possible for you to have the pitch of your choice (grass or hardstanding) but we will try our best to accommodate your preference.

If you are booking with family or friends, please inform us when you book so that we can try and site you on adjacent pitches if available.

Sanitation - Servicing chemical toilets must only be done at the chemical disposal point, using water from that source.

Liability

Barons Court Caravan Park will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to the property of the guest, including personal belongings, cash, jewellery and motor vehicles, however caused during their holiday.

In line with Caravan and Motorhome Club rules, we reserve the right to refuse acceptance or to terminate the visit of any person whose conduct, or that of their animals, is detrimental to us or to our other visitors.
