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Barons Court – Terms and Conditions

Bookings

This is a Caravan and Motorhome Club Certificated Location, which accepts just five caravans, motorhomes, campervans, folding campers and trailer tents and is for **Caravan and Motorhome Club Members only**.

During July and August, there is a minimum booking of 2 nights.

We are open all year – we have 4 hardstandings. We **do not** allow Motorhomes and campervans on the grass pitches at any time of the year.

Tarriff

All of our pitches have electric hook up and they are £17.50 a night per pitch. We do not charge extra for dogs, additional cars, gazebos, etc. We would like to state that the maximum number of people on a pitch is 6.

All prices are correct at the time of going to print and may be changed at any time. All bookings made prior to changes will be honoured.

Payment

A £17.50 non-refundable deposit will be asked for at the time of booking and the outstanding balance must be paid on day of arrival. Please make cheques payable to Mrs S Jones. We do accept BACS payment – details on the Booking In Form. We do not accept credit or debit cards and Site night vouchers.

Cancelling and Changing a Booking

If you wish to change or cancel your booking, please ensure you do so in good time so as to give others an opportunity to rebook the pitch. All deposits are non-refundable.

Arrival

Pitches are available from 2 pm. Pitches will usually be held until 8 pm of the day of arrival. Where a booking is not taken up by this time it will be considered cancelled, unless prior arrangement has been made with Barons Court.

On arrival, please report to Barons Court (house) and we will have pleasure in showing you your pitch.

We have a 6 metre rule which means that units (excluding guy ropes) must be 6 metres apart from adjacent units in order to protect against fire.

Please ensure the mains electrical cable from the hook up point to your unit and the unit's installation are safe. All units should be protected by a residual current device (RCD).

Departure

Pitches should be vacated by 11 am on the day of departure. Please ensure you leave your pitch clean and tidy on departure.

Children

Children are welcome at Barons Court and are your responsibility. They are very welcome to stroke the animals (under supervision) but please do not allow them to play in the fields where the animals are. Please ensure they wash their hands after they have stroked the animals.

BBQs

Barbeques must be purpose built and portable, standing clear of the ground. There must be no possibility of damage to the ground. Only gas or charcoal barbeques should be used. We can provide you with bricks to raise your BBQ off the ground. Please put all the ashes (once cooled) in the metal bin provided (near the recycling).

Livestock

We do have livestock on the smallholdings which you are welcome to stroke (but please do not enter the fields unless you are accompanied by Steph or Nick). Please do not feed any of the animals. Please do not put things over the fence eg towels as they may be eaten by the goats!! After petting the animals, please ensure that you wash your hands immediately.

Pets

Well behaved pets are welcome at Barons Court but you are responsible for the behaviour of your animals. Please ensure that your animals are not allowed loose on site and are kept on a lead. The maximum number of dogs per pitch is 2 large dogs or 3 small dogs.

We do not allow on site any breed (Pit Bull Terrier, Japanese Tosa, Dogo Argentino and Fila Brasileiro) of dog listed under the Dangerous Dogs act 1991.

With the exception of assistance dogs, pets are not allowed in the toilet and shower block.

Please ensure that you clear up after your dog(s). A bin is provided (near the recycling).

We do have livestock on the smallholding so please do not let your dog(s) worry the livestock. Ask Nick or Steph which field you can walk your dog(s) in as it depends where the sheep are at the time.

There are lots of walking and cycle routes nearby. Please familiarise yourself with The Countryside Code.

Noise

Noise must be kept to a reasonable level at all times so as not to disturb the enjoyment of others. Noise should be kept to a minimum between 10 pm and 7 am.

Gazebos and Pup Tents

Gazebos and pup tents are permitted on Barons Court as long as it is within your pitch.

Sanitation

Servicing chemical toilets must only be done at the chemical disposal point, using water from that source.

Recycle

Please could you place your rubbish in the recycling bins provided.

General

Campers are not permitted to use Barons Court as a base for running a business, carrying out work or as a main place of residence.

Please consider other users of the site and we ask that all members of your party and any guests conduct themselves at all times with due regard to the health and safety of themselves and others.

A maximum stay allowed is 28 days, after which time your pitch must be vacated for 24 hours before you can return to the pitch.

No hen or stag parties please.

Liability

Barons Court Caravan Park will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to the property of the guest, including personal belongings, cash, jewellery and motor vehicles, however caused during their holiday.

Electric Cars

Charging of electric cars is not permitted on site.
