## Cookery Corner - Margarets' Gingerbread

### Ingredients:

- 175g Black treacle
- 175g Golden syrup
- 175g Dark brown muscovado sugar
- 175g Butter
- 350g Plain flour
- $\frac{3}{4}$  teaspoon Bicarbonate of soda
- 1 tablespoon Ground ginger
- 1 teaspoon Mixed spice
- 150ml Milk
- 1 Egg, beaten
- 4 pieces Stem ginger, finely chopped

1. Grease and line a 20cm deep square cake tin. Preheat oven to Gas mark 3 / 170°C / 320°F.
2. Place the treacle, syrup, sugar and butter in a pan. Heat very gently, stirring occasionally, until the sugar has dissolved and the butter melted. Remove from heat.
3. In a large mixing bowl, sift together the flour, bicarbonate of soda, ginger and spice. Make a well in the centre.
4. Blend the milk into the sugary syrup and test the mixture. It should be no more than tepid. If it is too hot, leave to cool for a little longer.
5. Gradually pour the syrup mixture into the flour with the egg and chopped ginger, beating continuously with a wooden spoon. You should now have a smooth, shiny batter with a delicious spicy aroma.
6. Pour the mixture into the prepared tin and bake for 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$  hours until risen and a skewer comes out clean when inserted. Remove from the oven and leave in the tin for 1 hour before removing the paper and cooling on a wire rack.
7. Wrap in a sheet of fresh greaseproof paper and then foil. Store in an airtight container for at least 2 days before eating. This helps the cake to moisten and take on its classic chewy texture.
