IN-HAND Start 9.00am. Judge Ms C. Worcester

- R1 **Best Turned Out / Sunday Best** Any height
- R2 **Youngstock** Any height. 1 - 3 years old
- R3 **Coloured Horse or Pony** Piebald, skewbald, roan, palomino, dun and spotted
- R4 **Mountain and Moorland** Pure and Part-bred. Not including Shetlands
- R5 **Veteran Horse or Pony** 15 years and over
- R6 **Shetland / Miniature Horse** not to exceed 42 inches.
- R7 **Prettiest Mare** Any height
- R8 **Handsome Gelding** Any height

RIDDEN Start 2.00pm. Judge Ms C. Worcester

- R9 **Coloured Horse or Pony** Piebald, skewbald, roan, palomino, dun and spotted
- R10 **Mountain and Moorland** Including Shetlands
- R11 **Veteran Horse or Pony** 15 years and over
- R12 **Lead-Rein Pony** Not exceeding 14.2hh. Riders not exceed 10 years old
- R13 **Show Cob / Traditional Cob**
- R14 **Hunter** exceeding 14.2hh
- R15 **Family Horse or Pony** Suitable for all the family to ride
- R16 **Riding Pony** Not exceeding 14.2hh

CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners of all the above classes

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2019 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, South East, South. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In-Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

RULES

Neither the Oaks Driving Club, the Show Organiser, nor the landowner, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, save for death or injury caused by the negligence of these Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, accepts any liability for any accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any way whatsoever.

All animals must be kept under proper control at all times. All dogs must be on a lead at all times.

The Judge's decision is final. Objections must be made in writing within thirty minutes of the class having been judged, to the Secretary, accompanied by a deposit of £20 which shall be returnable should the objection be upheld.

Hard hats (BSI Standard 4472 6473 EN1384 or PAS015) with harness properly adjusted and fastened, must be worn at all times when mounted.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without giving a reason. anyone behaving in an irresponsible or offensive manner will be asked to leave the showground. Entries will only be refunded on production of a vet or doctors certificate.

No horse or pony under the age of 4 years may enter a ridden class.

Excessive use of whip and spurs is forbidden.

No galloping allowed on the showground.

Your signature on the entry form shall be deemed as an acceptance of the above rules.
